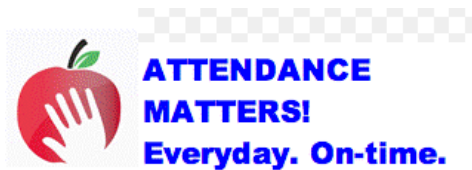

 The whole school attendance this week was **96.3%** - above our target of 95%, well done!



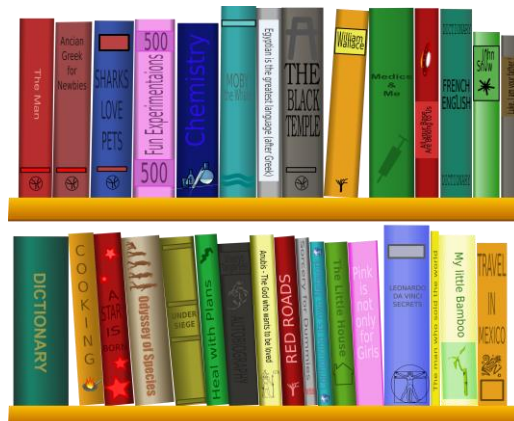
