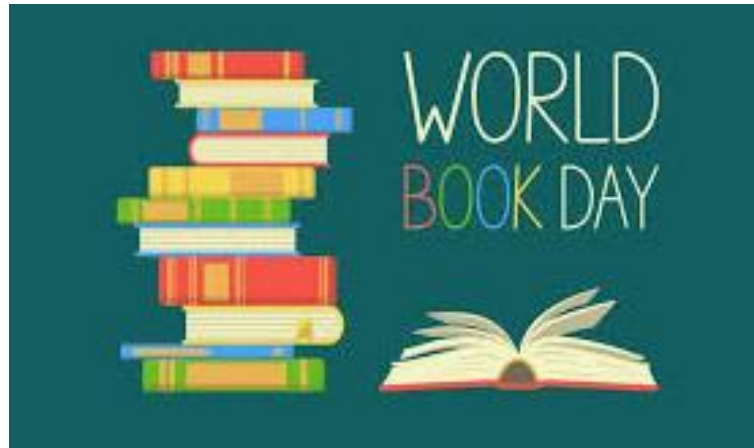

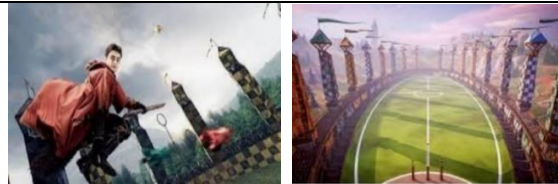

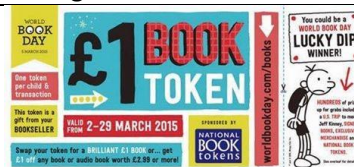

Please be aware of changes that have been made to our Attendance Policy regarding Early Collection.

Early collection of children (all collection before 3:10pm)

- Children are expected to remain in school for the full day. Where there are exceptional circumstances where a child needs to be collected early, the school will require evidence of any medical appointments or notification of the reason for early collection prior to the collection time.
- Parents/ carers will be asked to sign out their child at reception and give the reason for collecting. (NB These sheets will be monitored weekly by the Attendance Lead and DSAT EWO).
