Can we please ask that lunch accounts are kept in credit. Once a child reaches a debt of £13, they are no longer able to order school lunches. Thank you for your understanding.

New School Opening Hours – September 2024

Dear Parents and Carers.

From September 2024 the school day will be extending to ensure we adhere to the Department of Education statutory requirements that all schools provide 32.5 hours working week.

For children in FS2 to Y6, the school day will be as follow:

- 8.40am – Gates open and class doors are open.
- 8.55am – Gates closed and registration.
- 15.05pm – Gates open
- 15.10pm – End of school day for children.

To ensure consistency we will be changing our Foundation 1 timings also:

- The morning session will start at 8.40am and end at 11.40am.
- The afternoon session will start at 11.40am and end at 2.40pm.
- There will be the option of paying £2.50 to extend the afternoon session to 3.10pm.

Breakfast Club will continue to start at 8.00am at a cost of £2 a day.

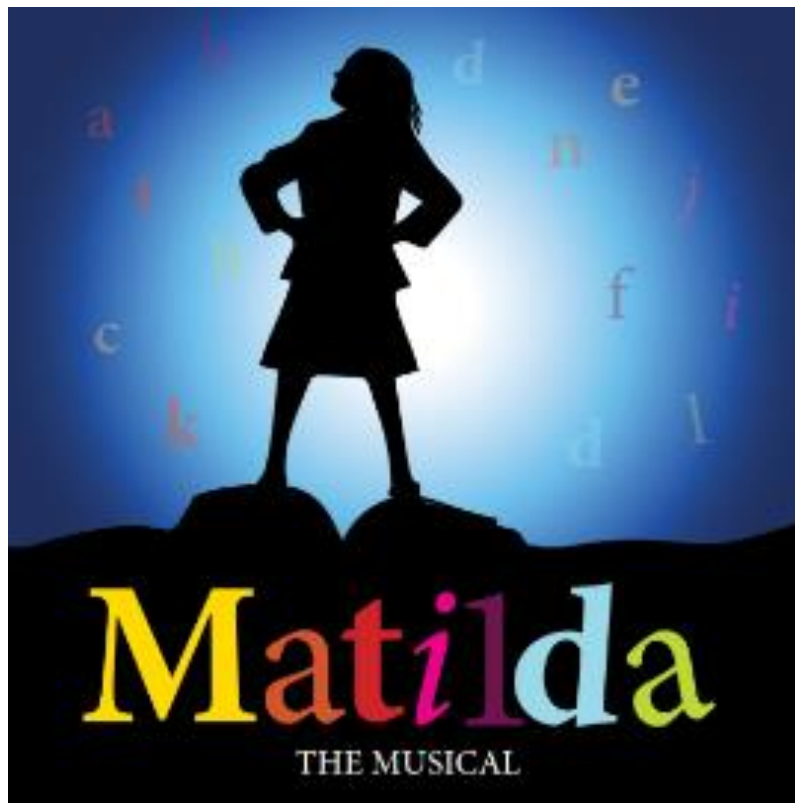

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday 19th July the pupils of Kilnhurst St Thomas Academy will be taking part in our sponsored 'Speed Challenge'. There is no fee for participation and every child in the school will take part.

Our Speed Challenge involves a giant inflatable football goal with integrated speed camera system. When a pupil (or teacher) takes a shot at goal the speed is displayed on a digital screen for all to see. Every child in the school will receive a personalised certificate showing their top speed on the day of the event.

Like many fundraising events, funds are raised via pupil sponsorship; children will ask friends and family members to sponsor them to take part in the speed challenge. Your school are not the only ones who can benefit from one of our fundraising events as we offer the pupils the opportunity to win prizes for their fundraising efforts. The more each child can raise, the more prizes they will win. Our prizes include, drinks bottles, gym bags, stationary, medals, trophies and footballs! Your school will receive 50% of all the money raised and all costs associated with running the event come out the remaining 50%.

The children will be shown a virtual assembly where the event will be explained to them. During this assembly the children will be informed of the importance of 'safe' fundraising. We ask that all funds raised are received from friends and family only and pupils are not to knock on doors or ask strangers to sponsor them.

Your child will be fetching a sponsor form home with them soon. The sponsorship form shows what prizes can be won as well as our website and contact details. Please do not hesitate in contacting us if you have any questions regarding the event.
