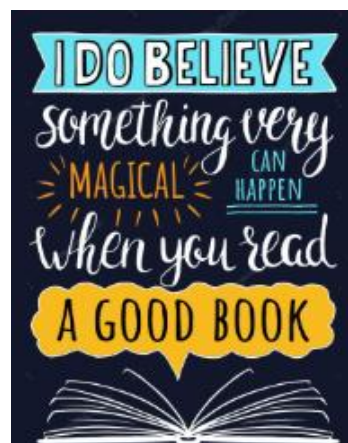

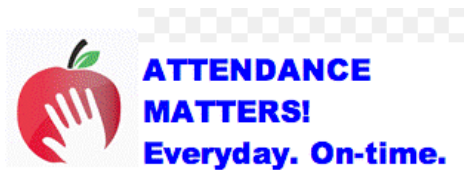

Introduction:

We are very excited that Kilnhurst St Thomas' CE Primary Academy are now affiliated with the NHS led "With Me in Mind" organisation. The service focuses on early prevention and intervention; ensuring children and young people, their families/ carers are able to access appropriate support to improve and maintain positive emotional wellbeing, to expand and widen positive self-esteem and to increase their self-efficacy in order to create resilience. Below are the sessions available in the Spring 2 term. Once finalised, more information will follow regarding Summer term sessions.

Tuesday 11/3/25 at 9am

Year 3 Worry Monsters (1 hour)

An arts and crafts workshop for parents/ carers and children to make worry monsters to use at home. The aim of the session is to start wellbeing conversations and promote emotional literacy. Please bring 1 cereal box if you are attending.

Thursday 13/3/25 at 2pm

Year 5 and 6: Supporting your child with school related stress. Adult only (1 hour)

This session will provide parents/ carers with advice and strategies to support children with school stress.
